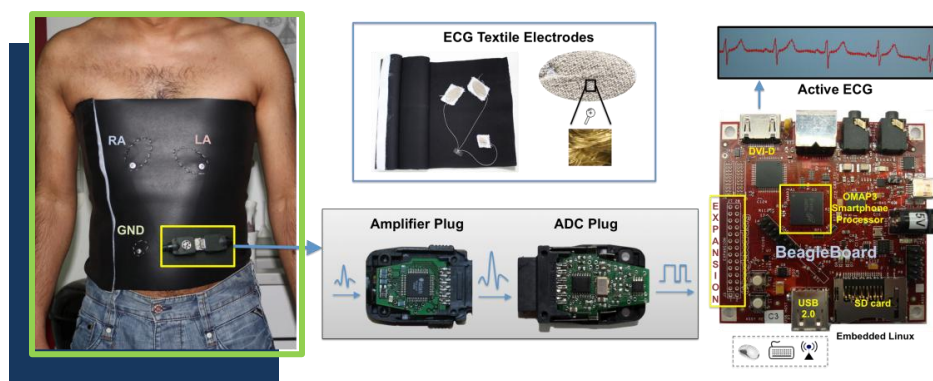
In October 2010, Kunal Mankodiya was awarded the
